Externship (variable crs.)
- Externship:** Tentative placements include Disability Law Center, Israel Law Center, Prime Minister's Office (Holocaust Claims), NGO Monitor, BIU Clinics, and private law firms
- Legal Tours:** Past tours include Israel Supreme Court (and private meeting with a Justice); Herzog, Fox, and Neeman (largest law firm); trial courts; dispute resolution center
- Cultural Tours:** Tour of Yad VaShem, Holocaust Memorial and Research Center, and Jerusalem (market, Center, and Old City) led by Professor Cogan; tour of old Tel Aviv and Yafo; students may also purchase tours through *Israel Experts* for weekend trips to cultural sites in Israel, Jordan, and Egypt
- Transportation:** Program provides daily transportation from Ben Yehuda/Beach area of Tel Aviv to Bar Ilan and return
- Hotel:** Program hotels available through *Israel Experts*; sublets through Tel Aviv realtors
