

Accommodations for the California State Bar Exam

Applicants with disabilities are encouraged to petition for accommodations for the California State Bar Exam at the beginning of their third year of law school and should file a petition no later than three (3) months prior to the exam they intend to take.

The bar exam is administered in February and July each year.

Requesting Testing Accommodations

The petition requires completing a series of [forms](#). All applicants must submit a [Petition For Testing Accommodations](#) (Form A). Applicants who received testing accommodations in law school must submit a [Law School Verification Form](#) (Form F). For verification purposes, the ADA Coordinator must fill out Form F. Please allow enough time for the ADA Coordinator to fill out the form. Additional required forms are specific to the applicant's disability and must be completed by a diagnostician or physician.
